The G.I.R.L. Agenda powered by Girl Scouts is a nonpartisan initiative to inspire, prepare, and mobilize girls and those who care about them to lead positive change through civic action. The multiyear effort celebrates the Girl Scout legacy of civic engagement, and for the first time ever, GSUSA is sharing free, expert-curated civic engagement resources beyond its 2.6 million members. The resources are derived from Girl Scout programming that has driven generations of girls over the past century to become leaders.

After a successful two years, the Goal Getter Reward is back! Please see that we have new requirements that will help your girl earn a free week at either Jockey Hollow Camp or Lake Rickabear Day Camp!

Goal Getter Requirements:

- Sell 6 magazine and 30 nut/candy items during the 2017 Fall Product Sale October 1-22. Online and traditional orders count!
- Sell 175 packages of Girl Scout Cookies during the 2018 Initial Order January 13-February 11. If not participating in the Fall Sale, girls must sell 550 packages of cookies during the Initial order. Digital Cookie and traditional orders count!
- Do a Service Project in your community with a minimum of 3 hours of service time and submit a re-cap of what you did. Feel free to submit a photo of your project as well! Service Project must be completed by February 1. Re-caps must be received by February 5. Email re-caps to goalgetters@gsnnj.org
- Service Project can be done as a troop, however each girl must complete the sales requirements and service hours individually.

Unfortunately, due to unforeseen circumstances, the previously scheduled Smart Sitter program has been cancelled. GSNNJ is offering a more detailed babysitting certification program facilitated by the American Red Cross. This program provides girls who are planning to babysit with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly give care for children and infants. This training will help participants to develop leadership skills; learn how to develop a babysitting business, keep themselves and others safe and help children behave; and learn about basic childcare and basic first aid. This program is facilitated by an American Red Cross Babysitter Instructor. Girls need to bring a brown bag lunch for the 30-minute lunch break, and will receive an American Red Cross Certification for completing the training. At least one registered adult Girl Scout member per troop/group must stay in the Service Center during the entire training session. Membership Registration Reminders

The 2018 Girl Scout year began October 1. **Leaders, please check your troop roster to ensure that all members are registered.**

- Go to www.gsnnj.org
- Click the yellow MYGS towards the right in the darker green band under the GSNNJ logo
- Select Member Profile
- Log into your MYGS account
- Click on the Troops tab
- Status is "Current" for members with 2018 memberships
- "Time to renew for 2018" appears as the status for those who have not yet renewed
- If you want to renew any members, make sure all members on the page have the correct renewal choice selected before clicking Continue at the bottom of the screen.
- Renew = I want to renew this person right now
- "I'll decide later" should be used for members not being renewed at that time
- Please note that choosing "Don't renew" removes the option to renew for that member and also triggers an automated email about leaving Girl Scouting to the family
- If "don't renew" was selected in error please contact Customer Care at 973-248-8200 so that the record with "Inactive" status can be corrected and the renewal option restored
- Please note that the "Add a New Member" option is for brand new first time members, not transfers of existing members
- Either leaders or families can renew members

Opportunity Catalogs for Troops and Volunteers

There are two parts to the Opportunity Catalog.

- The Troop Opportunity Catalog is an online listing of troop openings for girls at all program levels and in all zip codes. By entering a zip code, girls who want to join a troop can search for "opportunities" in a town near them.
- The Volunteer Opportunity Catalog lists openings for adults who want to volunteer to assist troops. This includes available roles in the troop, such as Leader/Advisor, Troop Committee Member, Troop Product Sales- Cookies and Troop Product Sales Fall. By entering a zip code, adults who want to join a troop and who want to volunteer can find "opportunities" in a town near them.

The Troop Opportunity Catalog

- If you haven't already done so, please complete the [Troop Information Update Form](#) to **ensure we have the most up to date information** for your troop.
- The second part of the form contains information about the **Troop Opportunity Catalog**. Please refer to our [FAQ Page](#) which answers some of the questions troop leaders have asked us about listing in the catalog.

- All new troops are automatically displayed with openings for 12 girls when they are created in Volunteer Systems unless a larger troop size has been requested by the service unit manager or troop leaders.
- We encourage all troop leaders to display their troops so new girls can find available options in their community.
- If each GSNNJ troop added one girl, more than 2,000 additional girls could discover the G.I.R.L. (Go-getter, Innovator, Risk-taker, Leader) in themselves!

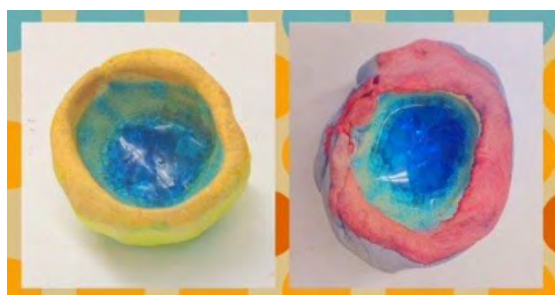

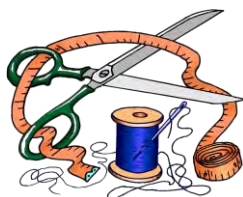
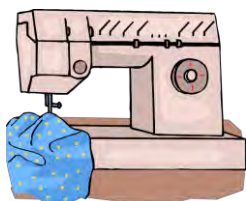
