Family Swim and Picnic at Lake Rickabear

NO ADVANCE RESERVATION REQUIRED.

Labor Day Weekend: August 31, September 1, 2, 2019 Daily from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. \$6 per person, per day for Girl Scout families. \$9 per person, per day for non-Girl Scout families.

Lake Rickabear is a 40-acre, spring-fed lake with a 700-foot

sandy beach. The facility offers fishing, miniature golf, outdoor bowling, volleyball, tennis, basketball, and more! Swimming and boating are permitted when a lifeguard is present at no additional cost. Charcoal grills and picnic tables are available, first come, first served.

Identification bands are issued upon check-in. All participants 3 years of age and older are required to wear their ID bands at all times. Replacement bands cost \$9.

Check in at the "Bear's Den" trading post, located across from the beach bathhouse, upon arrival at Lake Rickabear. Look for the blue flag. Lake Rickabear may close due to inclement weather at the discretion of the site manager on duty. There are no refunds. If there is no lifeguard on duty, waterfront activities will be shortened or cancelled.

(You will not have to share your tent or cabin.)


